# 1 WELCOME TO RIGA!

### HELLO, OUR DEAR PARTNER, HOW DID YOU ARRIVE?

Most likely, you arrived by airplane.

Therefore, you just need to leave the airport and, in front of the exit, there will be the city **BUS 22** waiting for you! It runs extremely frequently, so you won't miss it, and will take you to the heart of the city!

Also - single ticket works for 90 minutes - no matter how many rides and transport changes!



# two ways to get the ticket



At the driver on BUS 22

pay cash or card (but only on BUS 22); drivers are not talkative - it's not your fault



"etalons" booth for any other ride

before exiting the airport or elsewhere - buy a single or multiple ride, or a day ticket

If you arrived by any **international coach**, don't worry - the bus terminal is right next to Old Town and, after that - everything is walkable.





## November in Riga - remembering and celebrating

A glimpse into Riga's November spirit — from dazzling light installations to solemn torchlit processions and festive gatherings. Here are Latvia's key national celebrations:

#### Lāčplēsis Day – 11 November

Commemorates the 1919 victory at the Battle of Riga, a pivotal moment in securing Latvia's independence.

**Happenings:** Candle lighting along Riga Castle's walls and at the Brethren's Cemetery, torchlight processions honoring freedom fighters.

### Proclamation Day of the Republic of Latvia – 18 November

Marks the 1918 proclamation of Latvia's independence by the People's Council. **Happenings:** A grand military parade, concerts, and evening multimedia shows.









Even if it's chilly - get out and don't miss the scenic route.


